Noah And The Flood

Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

Before we get started today, let's take a few minutes to talk about the importance of obedience. Raise your hand if you obey your parents? (allow kids to respond) Good answer! Raise your hand if you obey your teachers? (allow kids to respond). Another good answer. Okay, here's a harder question. Raise your hand if you obey your parents every time? (allow kids to respond). Good for you. It's important to ALWAYS obey, not just every so often or when we feel like it.

In our lesson today, we're going to learn about a guy named Noah. He's super famous in the Bible. Raise your hand if you've heard of Noah before. (allow kids to respond). Don't worry if you haven't because we'll talk about him today. Noah learned how important it was to obey God. His life depended on it!

We'll talk about that some more in a few minutes. But first, let's stand and sing a song together.

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

Slide: Big Idea

All together:

Noah did exactly what God asked, the first time he asked. (Repeat)

Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- Why did God decide to send a flood? (People were evil)
- What did God ask Noah to build? (Boat/Ark)
- True or False: Noah's obedience saved his family and some animals. (T)

God was sad that all of the people had turned against him. They were disobedient and full of evil. Everyone except Noah. Noah actually loved God and he wanted to obey him. So, God decided to send a flood to wipe out all the evil. But, he would spare Noah and his family because Noah loved God. So, God gave Noah very specific instructions as to how to build a huge boat that would save him from being wiped out by the flood. Noah obeyed everything God told him to do and he did it exactly the way God told him to do it. So, when it was time, God told Noah to get on the boat with his family and some animals and get ready for the flood. When the flood came, everyone on the boat was safe but everything else was wiped out.

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"So, Noah did everything(pretend to hammer) exactly as God (point up) had commanded him." Genesis 6:22 *(Repeat)*

Did you catch what the verse said? Noah obeyed God and did everything he asked him to do. And, because Noah was obedient, his life was saved. We can learn from the story of Noah. Obeying our parents and teachers will help us to stay out of danger, too. So, when our parents give us rules at home, we should obey them all the time. When our teachers have rules in the classroom, we should follow them every time. This is what pleases God. He wants us to obey. And, when we obey our parents and teachers, we're obeying God! He gives us parents and teachers to help us in life. So kids, be sure to obey every time!
