# Wise Kids Are Obedient

## Slide: Welcome

*(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)*

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

## Slide: Series Intro

Let's get started by answering some questions! Where are some places we have rules? (allow kids to answer). Right, we have rules at home and school. What are some of the rules you have there? (allow kids to answer). Those are some good rules. Okay last question, why is it hard to follow rules sometimes? (allow kids to answer). Right, sometimes we want to do something but our parents or teachers say, "No."

Well in today's lesson we are going to learn why it's important to follow the rules and tips for how to do it. Another word for this is obedience. We should obey the rules we have at home, school, and everywhere!

We'll talk about that more in a few minutes, but first, let's stand and sing a song together.

## Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- What kind of kids should we hang out with? (obedient kids)
- When do you stop obeying? (Never!)

- True or False: Wise kids don't follow the rules. (F)

**Right! Wise kids DO follow the rules. The wisest kids are the ones who listen to the teacher when she asks them to be quiet, or listens to their parents when they're told to clean up their room. Wise kids know that obedience is important!**

**We don't follow rules just because it's a nice thing to do. Following rules is actually good for us. It helps us to stay close to God and it keeps us safe. When people tell us to do things they aren't trying to be mean, they're trying to help us because they know better than we do. And kids aren't the only people who have to obey.**

**That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.**

### **Slide: Memory Verse**

**"I will keep on obeying (march in place) your instructions (point up) forever and ever. (open arms wide)" Psalm 119:44 (Repeat)**

**See, obedience isn't just for when you're a kid. Obedience is for everyone, even adults. God wants us to be obedient all the time. That's why he gave us the Bible so we could know his rules that help us to live a good and safe life.**

**So kids, be wise kids who obey. Remember the three tips; Obey the first time, hang out with friends who are obedient and never stop obeying. These tips will keep us to stay on track and out of trouble!**

**Now let's all stand and sing one last song together.**

### **Slide: Big Idea**

**A wise kid will be obedient. (Repeat)**

### **Slide: Let's Pray**
