### **Slide: Welcome**

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

# **Slide: Series Intro**

I've got some question to get us started today! What is the hardest thing you have ever had to do? (allow kids to answer). Wow, those are some really hard things, I'm glad you were able to make it through them. Did you ever feel like giving up on that thing because it was too hard? (allow kids to answer).

Well in today's lesson we are learning another lesson about Moses. In our last lesson Moses had to leave Egypt. He was out living in the wilderness. In this story we are going to see how God asked Moses to do something really hard that seemed impossible.

We'll talk about that more in a few minutes, but first, let's stand and sing a song together.

All together: With God, nothing is impossible. **(Repeat)**

#### **Slide: Recap**

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- How did God speak to Moses? (Through a burning bush)
- What did God tell Moses to do? (Go back and rescue his people)
- True or False: If something is really hard you should give up on it. (F)

If Moses had just given up when he felt like it was going to be too hard then the Israelites would still be stuck in slavery. Moses would never have become the important Bible person that he was. See, Moses was afraid to go back to Egypt because he had killed someone. And, he was afraid to go before the king of Egypt, Pharaoh, because he was a mean and powerful guy. Moses didn't think he had what it took to accomplish God's plan. Maybe you've felt the same way. Maybe God has put on your heart to talk to the new kid at lunch or to invite a friend to church. It might feel scary and you might feel like you can't do it. Well, Moses felt the same way but look at what God said to him.

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

# **Slide: Memory Verse**

"God replied to Moses (cup mouth with hands), 'I Am Who I Am (point up). Say this to the people of Israel (cup mouth with hands): I Am (point up) has sent you (point out).'" Exodus 3:14 (*Repeat*)

When God said this to Moses he was telling him something really important. First, he was reminding Moses of who he was. God is the only God. He is big, strong and smart. He was also telling Moses that he has and always will be there to help him. He was there when Moses had to float down the river in the basket, he was there when Moses made a big mistake and killed the Egyptian slave driver, and he was there when Moses had to face Pharaoh and set the Israelites free.

The same goes for you! God is with you in the hard times and in the easy times. He will never leave your side. So next time you're facing something that seems impossible, remember who walks with you. God will help you to get through the hard stuff and keep you safe! With God, nothing is impossible!
