Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.) The

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

Before we get into our lesson today, let's think of all the words we can come up with that begin with the letter "O". (allow kids to respond) Those are some great ones. Well, today we're going to learn about another word that begins with the letter "O". This is a word you're going to want to remember because it will keep you out of danger. And, God tells us that we need to do it all the time. Hmmmm, what do you think it is? (allow kids to answer). You guys are too smart! The word we're going to talk about is obedience.

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

God knows everything, right? So, when he says we should do something, we should listen to it because he knows what he's talking about. God tells us to obey our parents. Here's why. God has given us parents to help us in life. And, parents have a big job. God wants them to take care of their kids by doing certain things to help their kids to grow up to be responsible adults. They have to feed us, give us a place to live and drive us to all the places we need to go. And, our parents give us rules to follow to keep us safe and away from danger. That's a lot of responsibility! Here's the good news. Our job is easy. All we have to do is listen and obey. That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"Obey (hand to ear like your listening) your parents, for this pleases (two thumbs up) the Lord." Colossians 3:20 *(Repeat)*

This verse is pretty clear. We're supposed to obey our parents. And when we do, we are making God smile. I don't know about you, but I want to make God happy. So, we should obey him by obeying our parents! It's a win-win. When we obey, we make God happy and we are kept safe from danger.

Now let's all stand and sing one last song together.
