Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

Today we are going to be taking a look at another story about Moses and Pharaoh, but first, let's see how much you guys remember about Moses's life! Who adopted Moses when he was a baby? (allow kids to answer). That's right, Pharaoh's daughter. Why did Moses have to leave Egypt? (allow kids to answer). He had to leave because he killed an Egyptian man. Last question, how many plagues did God send to Egypt? (allow kids to answer). Yeah, 10 plagues! Good job you guys, you remembered a lot about Moses.

Well in this lesson we are going to take a closer look at the 10th plague God sent to Egypt. This plague points to another story in the Bible.

We'll talk about that more in a few minutes, but first, let's stand and sing a song together.

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

Slide: Big Idea

All together:

Jesus is just like the passover lamb. (Repeat)

Video

Play lesson video.

Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- What kind of animal did God tell the people to pick? (a lamb)
- What were the Israelites supposed to do with the blood of the lamb? (paint it over the door)

- True or False: Just like the blood of the lamb saved the Israelites, the blood of Jesus saves us.
(T)

God had the Israelites put the blood of a lamb over their door so that he could see where his people lived. When he was passing over Egypt he looked for the blood, and if he saw the lamb's blood, he passed over that house and kept it safe. Because of the blood of the lamb the Israelites didn't lose their oldest kids. I know that sounds like a terrible story but God had to do it because of Pharaoh's disobedience.

Jesus did kind of the same thing for us. He came to the world, never sinned, died on a cross, and rose again. When Jesus died, his blood saved us from our sins. So, just like God passed over the homes of the Israelites because of the blood of the lamb, he passes over our sins because of the blood of Jesus. Jesus made it so we don't have to be separated from God and we get to live in heaven with him some day!

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"Christ, our Passover Lamb (point up), has been sacrificed for us (hands over heart)." 1
Corinthians 5:7 (Repeat)

Do you guys know that Jesus didn't have to die for us? He didn't. God didn't have to send his son down to earth to be bullied and killed just for us. But he did because he loves us! He was willing to give up his only son for us! He did all of that so we could have a relationship with him. That takes a lot of love. Jesus went through A LOT to wash away our sin, and all we have to do to be saved is ask him into our hearts. If you have never done that, but you want to, talk to a parent or teacher about it today! They would love to help you learn more about Jesus and show you how to accept him into your heart.

Now let's all stand and sing one last song together.
