

The Parable of the Hidden Treasure

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Lesson Overview

In today's lesson, we're learning about a famous parable that Jesus shared. A parable is just a story that teaches an important lesson in a creative way. In this parable, Jesus was talking about a hidden treasure. A guy finds a treasure, buries it, goes and sells all of his other belongings, and buys the field where he hid the treasure. Now, I bet everyone was confused by the story. Why would a guy find a treasure and not go and spend it all on cool stuff? And, why did he bury it again and sell all his stuff to buy the field? Well, Jesus was trying to teach bigger lessons to the people. See, the real treasure is Jesus. When we meet Jesus, we have found the real treasure because he offers us forgiveness from sins and new life in him. So, we should be willing to give up everything to have him. And, another lesson we learn from the parable is that we shouldn't bury Jesus and hide him. We should share him with our friends and family. Jesus is the real treasure so be sure to share him with others!

Classroom Agenda

1. (5 min) **Let kids start working on Activity Page #1.**
 2. (5 min) **WARM UP: If you found a hidden treasure, what would you hope to find in it?** (Tip: Maybe it's full of your favorite video games, candy or a stack of \$100 bills! All that stuff is great but nothing compares to Jesus!)
 3. (5 min) **PREVIEW: Write out the Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Key Question on a whiteboard.** Have the kids copy it down on Activity Page #1 (if applicable).
 4. (20 min) **LARGE GROUP: Gather for songs and videos with other kids.** Then return to class to finish this guide.
 5. (2 min) **RECAP: Read the Lesson Overview (see above).**
 6. (3 min) **KQ: Answer the Key Question.** (Answer: **Share Jesus with them and invite them to church.** (When we find Jesus and learn that he loves us so much that he died for our sins, gives us a new life, and the hope of heaven, how can we not want to share that news with others?! Tell your friends about him and invite them to come to church with you! Jesus is the best treasure ever!))
 - **Bonus Questions:** What should you share with your friends about Jesus? How does inviting friends to church help you to share Jesus? **4-5th** Who told you about Jesus? Who can you invite to church next week?
 7. (5 min) **EXPLORE: Read Matthew 6:19-21. Why shouldn't we care more about our stuff than Jesus? What do our priorities say about our hearts?** (Answer: Our stuff can't make us truly happy. Our video games or stuffed animals can't forgive our sins or help us to live a life that honors God. Only Jesus can do all of that. And, an important lesson for us to remember is; what we care about the most, is where our heart will be. That means, if we care more about buying more stuff or being popular, we'll spend our time chasing those things instead of chasing after Jesus. But, if we keep Jesus as our main priority, our hearts will fall more in love with him.)
 8. (10 min) **PLAY: Choose a group activity from Activity Page #2.**
- (5 min) **CLOSE: Share prayer requests and pray as a class.** Encourage kids to use the Family Guide at home with their parents - and remind them to go online to pursueGODkids.org to find this week's lesson video.

OPTION 2: FIND THE HIDDEN TREASURE GAME

Instructions:

- Before class, hide the coins (page 5) around the room or have the kids put their heads down and close their eyes so you can hide them.
- When you say, "Go!" have the kids race to find the hidden treasures. Each time they find a coin, have them tape it on the whiteboard. Once all the coins are found, work as a class to solve the hidden message. The message is "Jesus is our most valuable treasure"

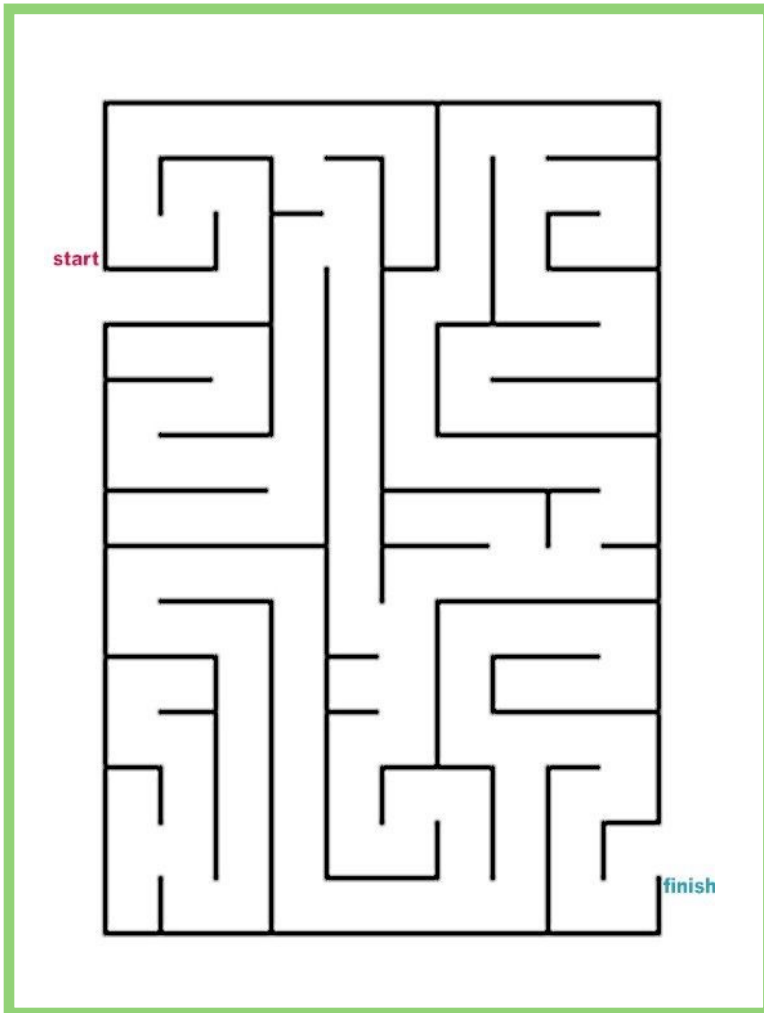

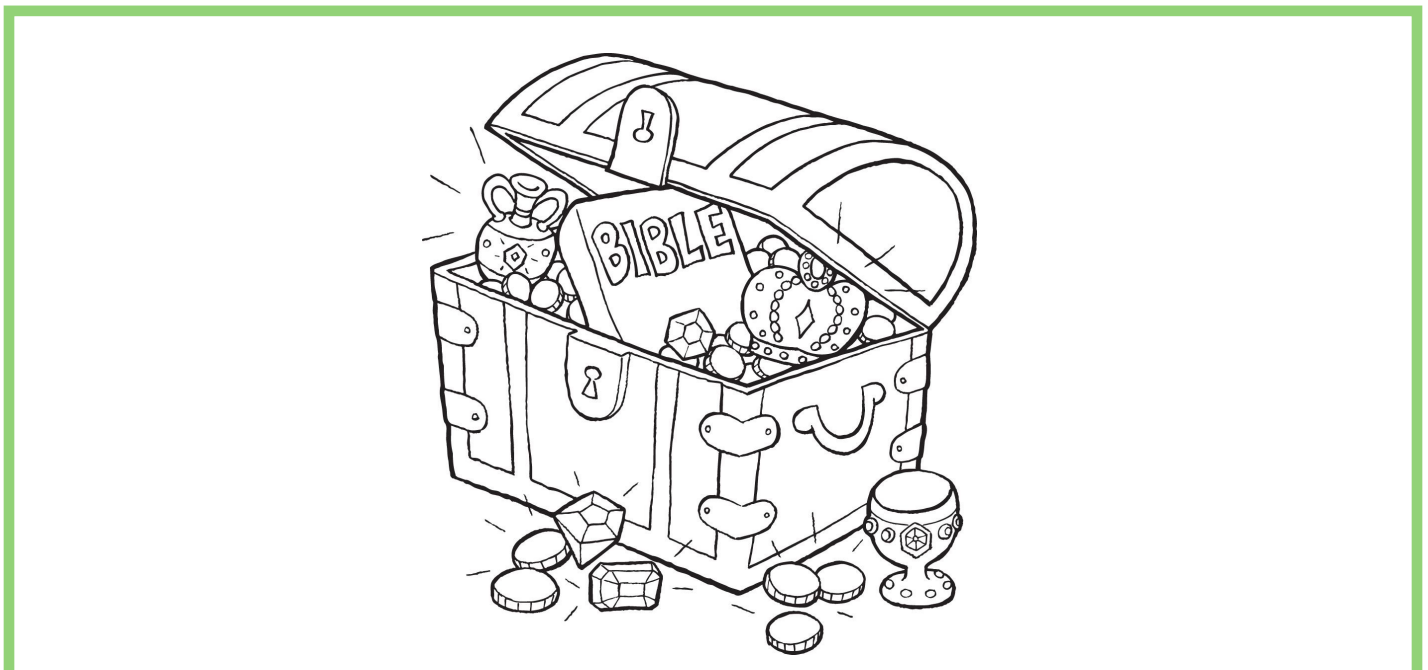
