# What Happened To Job

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## Slide: Welcome

*(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.) The*

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

## Slide: Series Intro

Before we get into our lesson today, I need your help to create a story of my worst day. I'll get us started. So, my alarm didn't go off this morning and now I'm late for church. Okay, now you guys help me come up with some more things that would make my day terrible. (allow kids to respond). Boy, you guys sure know how to come up with a bad day! I'm glad it was just pretend.

Well, in our story today, we're going to learn about a guy named Job who had a really bad day. And, it wasn't made up like our little scenario.

We'll talk about that some more in a few minutes. But first, let's stand and sing a song together.

## Song

*You are God*

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

## Slide: Big Idea

*All together:*

*God is with us in good times and bad. (Repeat)*

## Video

*Play lesson video.*

## Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- Who did we learn about today? (Job)
- What happened to Job? (lost everything)

- True or False: God is always with us no matter what. (T)

The story of Job is sad. Job was a really rich guy who loved God. But, one day, Satan went to God and said that the only reason why Job loved God was because Job had all this great stuff. And, if Job lost it all, he would turn against God. Well, God knew Job's heart but he decided to let Satan test Job to prove that Job really did love God no matter what. So, God allowed Satan to take all of Job's things, even his family. Now, I don't know about you, but that would be the worst day for me. I can't imagine how Job must have felt. One day he had everything. The next day he had nothing. But, Job did have something! He had faith in God. So, even though he was having a bad day, he still trusted that God would help him through it.

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

### **Slide: Memory Verse**

"Should we (point to self) accept only good (thumbs up) things from the hand of God (point up) and never anything bad (thumbs down)?" Job 2:10(Repeat)

Wow! These are Job's words while he's having a bad day. Instead of being angry at God and complaining about his horrible day, he trusted that God would help him through it. That's the point of Job's story. It's not that we should feel sorry for Job that he had a bad day. The point is how Job chose to respond. He trusted God's plan and stayed faithful to him.

This should be true for us, too. We're going to have bad days but that doesn't mean God has forgotten about us or doesn't love us. God is always with us, no matter what kind of day we're having. So, let's be like Job and trust God no matter what.

Now let's all stand and sing one last song together.
