Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

Today we are taking yet another look into Mose's life. Can anyone remember some of the things we've already learned about Moses? (allow kids to answer). Good job! We've learned how Pharaoh's daughter rescued him from a river, how he warned Pharaoh about the 10 plagues, that he parted the Red Sea, and how mad he was when the people made a golden cow to worship instead of God.

Well, in today's lesson we are going to see what happened when Moses went back up the mountain to see God again.

We'll learn more about that in a few minutes, but first let's stand and sing a song!

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

All together:

The more time we spend with God the more he'll rub off on us. (Repeat)

Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- Why did Moses go back up the mountain? (to get the ten commandments again)
- What did Moses look like when he came down the mountain? (he was shiny)
- True or False: If we spend time with God we will start to act like him, too. (T)

Moses had to go back up the mountain because he had broken the stone tablets where the 10 commandments had been written. So, he brought new tablets back up the mountain. While Moses was there, God decided to remind Moses of his power and love. He passed in front of Moses. His power was so awesome that Moses glowed! Moses was reflecting just a little bit of God. When he came back down the mountain, all of the Israelites could see his glow and that he was different. It reminded them that only God is worthy of their worship, not a silly cow. This can be true of us, too! When we spend time with God, we can be changed.

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"Put on your new nature (pretend to pull something over yourself), and be renewed as you (point out) learn to know (point to head) your Creator and become like him (point up)." Colossians 3:10 (Repeat)

This verse isn't telling us that we will actually start to look like God and get shiny like Moses. It's talking about how we will act differently when we spend time with God. When we read our Bibles, pray and go to church, God will rub off on us. We'll want to treat others the way God has treated us.

Just like the people saw how God had rubbed off on Moses, your friends and family can see how God has rubbed off on you. You can be a great reflection of God's love when you are kind and loving to your friends. They'll see that something is different about you. So, be a good reflector of God's love to the people in your life!
