# The Woman at the Well

## Slide: Welcome

*(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)*

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

## Slide: Series Intro

Today we are going to take a look at a really awesome story from Jesus's life. In this story Jesus meets a lady who had made some big mistakes in her life. Have you ever made a big mistake? (allow kids to answer). Me, too! Well, Jesus has a pretty important lesson to teach us about our mistakes!

We'll learn more about that in a few minutes, but first let's stand and sing a song!

## Song

*Another Day*

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

## Slide: Big Idea

*All together:*

Jesus wants a relationship with everyone, no matter what. **(Repeat)**

## Video

*Play lesson video.*

## Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- Why did Jesus sit down at the well? (he was tired)
- Why did the woman have no friends? (she had made a lot of mistakes)
- True or False: Some mistakes are too big for Jesus to forgive. (F)

There are no mistakes that are too big for Jesus to forgive! The lady he met at the well had made a lot of mistakes. She had done things that made all of the other people in village

dislike her. Lucky for her, she met Jesus that day. He told her he that he had come into the world to forgive the sins of everyone and to make them right with God. Her life was changed that day! She went from being sad, lonely, and ashamed of the things she had done to being excited and hopeful because she was forgiven through Jesus!

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

### **Slide: Memory Verse**

"We (point to self) are made right with God (point up) by placing our faith in Jesus Christ (hands over heart). And this is true for everyone (motion to kids) who believes no matter who we are (shake finger "no")." Romans 3:22 *(Repeat)*

Isn't that amazing! God loves us no matter who we are. This was especially true in the story we learned about today. The woman Jesus met at the well was a Samaritan woman and Jesus was a Jewish man. In those days it was pretty uncommon for those two types of people to talk! First, because Samaritans and Jews weren't friends and second, men didn't typically speak to women. Now, Jesus knew all of that but he still wanted this woman to know that he loved her and would forgive her of all of her mistakes.

This is true for us, too. Jesus came to die for our sins so that we could be forgiven for all of the mistakes we've made. If you want to have that relationship with him, but haven't asked him into your heart, talk to a parent or teacher about it today. They would love to help you understand more about what that means and how you can take that step!

Now let's all stand and sing one last song together.

### **Song**

### **Slide: Big Idea**

### **Slide: Let's Pray**

Pray and release the kids to small group.
