Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

We are going to get started by answering some fun question today! Our first question is what is the craziest dream you have ever had? (allow kids to answer). Oh wow! Those are some pretty crazy dreams. Dreams can be so crazy, huh!

In today's lesson we are going to talk about a dream that the apostle John had. God would appear to people in dreams sometimes to show them something important about the future. That's what he did for John. In fact, John wrote the very last book in the Bible called Revelation. Do you know what Revelation means? It means "uncovering" or to reveal. The whole book is full of how God revealed what would happen in the future and even what heaven will be like. In our story today, God showed John that Jesus would return to win the final battle for us.

We'll talk about that some more in a few minutes. But first, let's stand and sing a song together.

Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- What color was Jesus' horse? (white)
- Who followed Jesus? (the armies of Heaven)
- True or False: Jesus didn't fight a battle for us. (F)

Jesus fought a really important battle for us, and he won! Do any of you know what he fought for us? (allow kids to answer). Jesus fought sin for us. He fought it by coming to earth, living a sinless life, dying on the cross, and then rising again three days later. Because of that, Jesus made it so we don't have to suffer the consequences of our sin. One of the consequences of sin is being separated from God. Being separated from God would make life really sad so let's be thankful that Jesus fixed our sins so we can have relationship with God! And, thanks to him, we get to spend eternity in heaven with him someday. All we have to do is put our trust in Jesus. Jesus is amazing and powerful!

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"On his robe was written this title: (point to shirt) King of all kings (bow) and Lord of all lords. (point up)" Revelation 19:16 (*Repeat*)

This verse reminds us that Jesus is the most important and most powerful person ever. There might be a lot of important people in your life. In fact, can any of you think of some important people in your life? (allow kids to answer). See, there are a lot of important people. But we have to remember that no matter who we know, Jesus is still the most important person.

And that's what this lesson is about. Jesus came to fight the battle of sin for us. Jesus is the only one who can win the battles for us because he is God. Just like his robe said, He is THE King and he is THE Lord. And he will return to bring those who love him to heaven.
