Slide: Welcome

(Start kid's countdown once all classes are present.)

Hey kids! Welcome to Kid's Church. I'm so glad you could be here today.

Slide: Series Intro

Leader Tip: Come into group dressed like a king (crown and a robe). Introduce yourself as Solomon and tell the group you were just made king! Act excited about this new position and tell the group that you want to be the best king ever! Tell them that you're going to pray to ask God for his help. Ask the kids what you should ask for to be the best king? After allowing a few kids to share, tell them that in the lesson they'll discover what Solomon asked God to give him. It may surprise them!

Before we jump into our lesson this week, I have a question for you. If you were made king of a country, what would you need to be a good king? (allow kids to answer). Those are some good answers. (If you did the Leader Tip, review some of the answers the kids gave for what Solomon might have asked God to give him.)

Well in today's lesson, we are going to learn what Solomon asked God to give him when he was made king.

But, before we get into that, let's stand and sing.

Good job! I think God loves hearing all your voices praising him! Now let's say our Big Idea together.

Slide: Big Idea

All together: Don't forget to pray for wisdom. (Repeat)

Slide: Recap

So, what did we learn from the video today? Let's review...

- What did Solomon ask God to give him? (Wisdom)
- What story made Solomon's wisdom famous? (2 women and a baby)
- True or False: God's wisdom can help us, too. (T)

Wisdom is the ability to know what's right and wrong and then the ability to make the right choices. So, wisdom is really important if we want to live our lives to honor God. Remember, God is the creator of the whole universe so he knows everything and he knows what's best for us. So, we should ask God for his wisdom. And, guess what? When we ask, he will give it to us!

That reminds me of our memory verse. Let's all stand and say it together.

Slide: Memory Verse

"If you need wisdom (point to head), ask our generous God (point up), and he will give it to you. (arms open wide)" James 1:5 (*Repeat*)

Solomon was smart when he asked God for wisdom. And, God gave him lots of it. Solomon is famous for his wisdom! So, just like our memory verse says, when we ask God for wisdom, he will give us lots of it, too! And, remember, the Bible is full of God's wisdom so be sure to read it and obey it!

So kids, let's be like Solomon and be famous for our wisdom!
